
Title: And the Train Goes... Suitable for: 2+ years

PAPER TRAINS

You will need:

- a copy of template
- coloured pencils, crayons or textas
- large sheet of coloured paper approx. 18cm x 60cm
- scissors & glue
- wool
- empty icecream container

Instructions

Use the templates on the next page to make different trains. Below are four ideas for you to try.

Train no. 1

- 1. Colour in the train, passengers, guard and driver.
- 2. Cut out the passengers, driver and guard and glue to the train in their appropriate places.

Train no. 2


- 1. Colour in and cut out the train, passengers, guard and driver. Glue to large sheet of coloured paper.
- 2. Try drawing in a background scene.


Train no. 3

- 1. Colour in the train, passengers, guard and driver.
- 2. Cut out the passengers, driver and guard and glue to the train in their appropriate places.
- 3. Cut out around the train and carriages, attach to long piece of wool and hang up.

Train no. 4

- 1. Colour in the train only.
- 2. Cut out and glue around an icecream container.
- 3. Use the container for crayons, textas, small toys etc.








The driver sits in the engine cab.
